NEW BOOST TO DIALOGUE AND SOCIAL CONSENSUS

November 2016

The President of the Government undertook, during his Investiture Debate on 26 October, to *“immediately call the social stakeholders to share our analysis on the social and economic situation and to tackle new measures to strengthen the **creation of new, quality jobs, assistance for the long-term unemployed, the implementation of the youth guarantee, as well as the sustainability of our public pension system, within the framework of the Toledo Pact**”*.

The Government and the social stakeholders consider, now that a new government has been formed with all its inherent powers, that it is necessary to adopt urgent measures within the framework of social dialogue to improve **job quality, facilitate the return to work** of the long-term unemployed, make improvements to the **implementation of the European Youth Guarantee**, and establish a strategy to determine the Inter-Professional Minimum Wage (Spanish acronym: SMI), among others, which will be the subject of work and analysis within the framework of social dialogue.

CERTAIN AREAS COVERED BY SOCIAL DIALOGUE PROCESS

1. **Consolidation of economic recovery with growth and employment to foster opportunities and reduce inequalities.**
2. **Increase protection for the unemployed with particular focus on the long-term unemployed, and boost Active Employment Policies.**
3. **Improve the functioning of the European Youth Guarantee in Spain and other measures to achieve its goals of reducing youth unemployment.**
4. **Revision of Inter-professional Minimum Wage.**
5. **Boost Job Quality; framework for labour relations and collective bargaining.**
6. **Strengthen Public Pension System.**
