And one last question for this ethical dimension of the AI.

You know that, well, under the the Spanish presidency of the European Union Council, we passed before the European Parliament the first act on AI and in Spain we just created, like some months ago, the first public national agency for AI in La Coruña, in Galicia. How do you see not in Europe or in China or in the US, how do you see agreeing in these three regions in common grounds for an ethical approach of the AI?

The point is that when you you see it from our side, the regulator, we feel that we are running behind.

But anyhow, talking about laws, two years ago, we passed a very important law in our national parliament, which is the Startup Law. And you were talking about attracting international talent to Barcelona, which is a gorgeous place to attract international talent. And I think that under this law, we included the possibility of expiring this these nomad digital visas.



So I invite all your students to come to visit Spain, and why not work for a while in Spain?

But also, you know, in this law we reduce all these burdens that always are like the big obstacles for entrepreneurs and startups. Also the tax reductions for startups.

So I think that we are within the European Union very competitive. And what we need now is, you know, that human capital and that international talent.

So, you know, consider us as an ally for you and for the different sectors that are represented here.

And by the way, I can tell you that in my conversations with the Prime Minister and the presidency, I shared as one of our outstanding cooperation, the one that we have here in this university. And this is something that, you know, makes us feel proud. And I think that we have to strenghten in the future this kind of cooperation.
